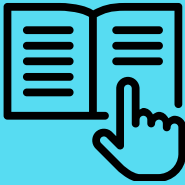


ORAL READING FOR LANGUAGE IN APHASIA (ORLA)

1.) CLINICIAN READS ALOUD TO PATIENT, POINTING TO EACH WORD AS THEY GO

2.) SAME AS STEP 1, WITH PATIENT ALSO POINTING



3.) SAME AS STEP 2, WITH PATIENT ALSO READING

4.) FOR EACH LINE OR SENTENCE, CLINICIAN STATES A WORD AND PATIENT FINDS IT



5.) FOR EACH LINE OR SENTENCE, CLINICIAN POINTS TO A WORD AND PATIENT READS IT

6.) CLINICIAN AND PATIENT READ ALOUD PASSAGE TOGETHER AGAIN
